

The Islamia University of Bahawalpur scored hundred percent in the Higher Education Commission's online classes readiness board. The Higher Education Commission issued ranking of universities in terms of their performance in online classes. The universities ranked for university readiness, course readiness, faculty readiness, technology readiness, library

Engr. Academic Council Approves Online Classes

Academic Council of the Islamia University of Bahawalpur approved mechanism of online education including online teaching and assessment in the wake of Covid-19 pandemic emergency. Engr. Prof. Dr. Athar Mahboob, Vice Chancellor presided the meeting while members included Deans, Registrar, Controller Examinations, Treasurer

and Directors Academics, IT, and Quality Assurance. The participants reviewed performance of online classes held during spring semester 2020 and decided to conduct composite online examination. A comprehensive discussion was carried out regarding health policy of faculty and students, online teaching and assessment

and learning management system. It was also decided that faculty members will decide on their own regarding assessment of MPhil and PhD scholars through online exams or assignments. Director Academic will notify schedule of online exams which will be displayed on University website. The result cards of students will be dispatched

through email or courier service. The students will be given option to freeze their semester due to non-availability of internet or relevant facilities and their semester fee will carry on to next semester. Controller Examinations will soon announce online examination policy regarding affiliated colleges and private students.

Webinar on Reopening of the Educational Institutes Post Covid 19

On 18th May 2020, Center for Global & Strategic Studies (CGSS) organized an International webinar on the topic, "Reopening Of The Educational Institutes Post COVID-19: Effects And Precautions To Be Observed", At this time of the health crisis, educational sector all over the world is effected badly and countries are taking practical measures to avoid the educational loss. The aim of the Webinar was to consolidate all the sufficient measures from different countries including Hungary, Russia, China and other European countries. Mr. Niaz Ahmad, Vice-Chancellor, University of the Punjab, Lahore stated that in these testing times, Punjab University has made virtual education effective. This Pandemic has hit our country when universities were at their completion of the session. Punjab Universities focusing on international advancements in educational system. Dr. Asif Ali, Vice-Chancellor, MNS University of Agriculture, Multan mentioned that they have developed a formula for their own special hand sanitizer amid the prevailing COVID-19 crises in Pakistan and the classes are being shifted to online programs. Engr. Prof. Dr. Athar Mahboob, Vice Chancellor, Islamia University of Bahawalpur stated that the students and teachers are following the instructions, once the university will revive its classes, reconsideration is very important to maintain the same precautionary measures. In this new post-COVID world new modules

and new learning traditions would be introduced. Laboratory tools have to be virtualized for example computer studies. Furthermore, he stated that very close watch for the virus is needed and especially the research in microbiology. Mr. Faisal Mushtaq, CEO, The Millennium Education University, Islamabad stated that we need to redefine the digital inclusive education, and digital inclusion. We have to turn towards digital medium. The key consideration is to build trust in the digital education system. This is the time to reconsider the infrastructure readiness for the crises in educational institutes and new normal has to be prepared. Ms. Wang Qianting, China Media Group, Beijing, stated that China has taken sufficient measures. We are practicing tests at every educational institute. We monitor the temperature twice a day, even AI robots are also active for testing COVID-19 and especial vehicles have been arranged for the people. Professor Xu Wenhong, Institute of Russian, East European & Central Asian Studies, China Academy of Social Sciences (CASS), Beijing, China stated that before opening the education institutes it is important to record travel history of students and faculty and to instruct the parents about the threat of the pandemic. All the educational institutions have reasonable planning including medical supplies and medical centers. After the reopening of the educational institutes, controlling an emergency program has been

Secretary Agriculture South Punjab Praises Cotton Research at IUB

Secretary Agriculture South Punjab Saqib Ali Atil has appreciated the agricultural research activities in Islamia University Bahawalpur. He said that Jamia Islamia under the leadership of Engineer Prof. Dr. Athar Mehboob Vice Chancellor is performing well in all fields especially the research on cotton crop. Secretary Agriculture South Punjab expressed these views while talking to Prof. Dr. Muhammad Iqbal, Chairman, Department of Plant Breeding and Genetics and Director Research, Islamia University, Bahawalpur. Dr Muhammad Iqbal said that the cotton varieties produced by Jamia Islamia have been cultivated in 40% of the area of South Punjab and this success was also mentioned in a briefing presented to the Prime Minister of Pakistan. He said that Jamia Islamia was currently conducting research on three important issues of cotton. Among them, farm yield is being increased from 35,000 to 40,000 plants per acre of cotton. For this purpose,

experimental cultivation is also being carried out in collaboration with Aveol Group of Companies and progressive farmers. Similarly, work is underway to develop varieties of cotton-free virus. The third major problem for the cotton crop is the whitefly, for which varieties are being developed that

provide resistance to the whitefly. He said that the university was developing virus-free and whitefly-resistant varieties. These types will be announced by the Vice Chancellor soon at an important and appropriate time. Similarly, on the direction of the Vice Chancellor, Farmers' Day will

be celebrated at the University in which farmers from all over South Punjab will participate and agronomists will be apprised of the latest developments. He appreciated the steps taken and assured all possible cooperation from his side.


World Book and Copyright Day observed at IUB

The Islamia University of Bahawalpur is a leading University of the Country having 800 faculty members imparting education to 26000 students in 48 teaching departments and 5 constituent colleges in seven faculties. The University has 5 campuses, 3 are located in Bahawalpur while other two are located in Bahawanagar and Rahim Yar Khan. Further, there are more than 100,000 off campus students in 150 affiliated colleges. As soon as national emergency declared by the Government due to Corona Virus outbreak in the country, the University announced holidays as per direction received from the Higher Education Department. All hostels were vacated and around 8000 boarders were sent homes. The Islamia University of Bahawalpur emerged as a leading university to stand with the nation in the hard times of International crises. Following measures were taken, following policy guidelines of the Federal Government through the Higher Education Commission and the Punjab Government through the Higher Education Department.

Online Education System through ICT blended Learning Management System -Winning 100 % Score on HEC Online Readiness Dashboard

keeping in view the precious time of around 26,000 on campus and 100,000 off campus students practicing social distancing at their homes, it was decided to engage them in productive manner, fast paced steps were taken to establish an Information Communication Technology blended distance education platform. This step was truly in line with guidelines received from the Higher Education Commission, Punjab Higher Education Commission and Higher Education Department. A portal <https://lms.iub.edu.pk> and <http://my.iub.edu.pk> has been launched and all faculty member and students are onboard having received their logins and passwords to immediately resume their academic activities. Course material, assignments, syllabus books are being provided through this portal. The main features if this ICT Blended Education Model are:-

1. Online classes, information and communication technology assisted education delivery
2. Availability of learning materials to all 26000 students and its communication through SMS service.
3. Student teacher interaction through a variety of synchronous and asynchronous communication technologies such as SMS, Email, WhatsApp, LMS, Big Blue Button, Jitsimeet, Zoom, audio recordings, etc.
4. Student assessment through paper-based exams at the end or otherwise online exams.

Recently, the IUB has obtained 100 % online readiness score on HEC website leading among public sector universities across Pakistan. **Provision of 8 University Hostels for Quarantine Facilities**

The University immediately handed over six girls hostels located at Baghdad ul Jadeed Campus and two in sub-campuses in Bahawalnagr and Rahim Yar Khan for Quarantine facilities on the request of the Punjab Government through District Administrations. As

many as 1450 corona patients can be accommodated in these hostels. **Preparation of WHO Standard 5000 bottles of Hand Sanitizers and provision to on duty Staff Members, Doctors and Law Enforcement Agencies**

It was observed that there is shortage of the most demanded sanitizers in the market. The Pharmacy Department having laboratory facilities available having willing faculty members and students of IUB Science Society started preparing WHO Standard bottled hand sanitizers. On urgent basis these sanitizers were provided to on duty Security and Estate Care Staff. The volunteer students moved to Bahawal Victoria Hospital and handed over these sanitizers to on duty doctors. They also distributed these sanitizers to Police Constables performing duties in the city areas. Recently, these sanitizers were dispatched to Lodhran Police, DHQ Lodhran , THQ Yazman and Radio Pakistan and on duty FM Radio staff. The Pharmacy lab is continuing production of the sanitizers from university resource to fulfill demand of both University




Pakistan and Effect of Deforestation on Climate Change. Department of Environmental Sciences is also

Cholistan Institute of Desert Studies (CIDS), the Islamia University of Bahawalpur organized seed broadcast activity in Cholistan desert during recent rains under Clean and Green Pakistan Campaign. Engr. Prof. Dr. Athar Mahboob, Vice Chancellor said that the main objective of this activity was to restore the indigenous flora of Cholistan desert especially the plant species. Migratory birds feed on desert insects and plants but due to overgrazing, drought, over exploitation of vegetation for fuel, timber and medicinal purposes, Cholistan desert is losing its biodiversity. Therefore, it was planned to broadcast the seeds of indigenous flora the form of seed balls and direct seed broadcast. Dr. Muhammad Abdullah, university faculty member and activity organizer stated that seeds of indigenous plants were

collected from Cholistan and Seed balls making process was carried in university laboratory. The University is also working on establishing a seed bank and conservation of desert plants in

experimental area. Prof. Dr. Shazia Anjum, Director, Cholistan Institute of Desert Studies briefed that Cholistan is a fragile ecosystem which is losing its native flora and fauna ultimately losing its potential

to support migratory birds. Seed broad cast is an excellent conservation technique to restore desert to its original form.
