The Islamia University of Bahawalpur announced full fee waiver for position holders of BA, BSc and BCom examinations to study in master classes in the University. This was stated by Engr. Prof. Dr. Athar Mahboob, Vice Chancellor during a ceremony to award cash prizes and certificates to position holders of annual examinations 2019. Mr. Nayyer Iqbal, Commissioner Bahawalpur Division was the chief guest of the event who praised the efforts of the university promoting higher education in the region. Controller Examinations Zuriatul Zahra briefed about details of examinations and position holders. On this occasion, cash prizes worth Rs. 50,000 were awarded to 1st position holder, Rs. 30,000 to 2nd and Rs. 20,000 to 3rd position holder along with distinction certificates. It is important to mention that it is for the first time in the history of the Islamia University of Bahawalpur

that position holders have been offered 100% scholarship for further studies in the university. As many as total 9888 candidates appeared in BA examinations and 5652 were declared successful showing 57.16 pass percentage. Ehtisham

Amjad, Govt. Degree College for Boys, Minchanabad got 1st position securing 670 marks, Samar Noreen of Govt. Degree College of Haroobabad declare 2nd getting 661 marks while Maryam Idrees and Areeb Shoukat shared 3rd position

obtaining 554 respectively from Govt. Degree College for Women Satellite Town Bahawalpur and Iqra Post Graduate College for Women Sadiqabad. In BSc 11576 candidates attempted the exam and 5876 were declared passed with percentage of 40.66. Usman Liaqut of Govt. Post Graduate College for Boys, Chishtian got 1st position having 695 marks, Muhammad Ijaz from Govt. Post Graduate College for Boys, Bahawalnagar stood 2nd getting 694 marks while Bilal Sharif declare 3rd obtaining 680 marks. In BCom 473 candidates appeared in the exam and 298 were declared pass showing 63 pass percentage. Sidra Akram Govt. Sadiq College of Commerce, Bahawalpur, got 1st position having 1277 marks, Aftab Malik from Allama Iqbal College Ahmedpur East, stood 2nd getting 1220 marks while Muhammad Haris Yameen from Govt. Sadiq College of Commerce Bahawalpur declared 3rd obtaining 1209 marks.

MoU with Livestock Department



IUB receives 56,657 applications for Fall Admissions 2019

The Islamia University of Bahawalpur received 56657 applications for bachelor and master programs in admissions of fall semester 2019. This season the University carried out a comprehensive admissions campaign on directions of Vice Chancellor Engr. Prof. Dr. Athar Mahboob. In order to project the university academic programs, enhancing visibility of the university in educational horizon and attracting large number of admission seekers,

admission cell introduced a smooth online admission process. Admission facilitation center was also established at Abbasia Campus for guidance of students and parents, as a result immense number of students applied from across Punjab as well as other provinces including Gilgit Baltistan. During the last two months, Vice Chancellor Engr. Prof. Dr. Athar Mahboob has paid special attention on improving the boarding facilities as well as food quality in

hostels and canteens, availability of standardized medical and transport facilities to students. He announced admissions for position holders on 100% scholarship in all departments of the university.
