

he Department of Physiology, the Islamia University of Bahawalpur organized First National Hands-on Training Workshop in Clinical Electrocardiography (ECG) at the Main Auditorium of Baghdad ul Jadeed Campus, the Islamia University of Bahawalpur. Majorly, the learning outcome of the workshop was to understand the principles of ECG and learn a step-by-step approach in performing and interpreting an ECG test for appropriate diagnosis in human and veterinary clinical practice. As per the Chief Organizer of the workshop, Dr. Umer Farooq Chairman Department of Physiology, a few of its objectives included, to inculcate the basic knowhow of

ECG as a diagnostic tool in human and veterinary medical profession within the target participants, to understand and disseminate the diagnostic approach of ECG for mainstream clinical indications/ cardiac disorders both in human and veterinary practice, to create awareness about diagnostic efficacy of ECG as a simple tool for research, academics and primary-care health practice. 





Institute of Physics Conducted Scientific Experiments in Cholistan Desert

keeping this in mind, two related experiments were performed. One was the display of water splitting utilizing solar energy. Water splitting is the chemical reaction in which water is broken down into oxygen and hydrogen. Efficient and

contains large amount of water in the form of vapour, moisture etc. Within those amounts almost 30% of the water is wasted. This amount of water can be used if we are able to extract the water that is present in air in form of moisture. The

economical water splitting would be a technological breakthrough that could underpin a hydrogen economy, based on green hydrogen. The second experiment was the production of water through air using Peltier elements. Atmosphere project was an attempt to make device that is capable of converting atmospheric moisture directly into usable and even drinking water, especially in an environment which is very close to nature, and free from many external factors, and also in need of such products. Besides these two experiments the students also collected desert plants for the green synthesis of nanoparticles. Addressing to the occasion, the Director Institute of Physics, Prof. Dr. Saeed Ahmad Buzdar highlighted the importance of natural resources and emphasized on the development of such projects for the benefits of life on earth. Institute of Physics is committed to work more on these themes in nearby future. 
