The Islamia University of Bahawalpur is the first university in Pakistan where the Inter-University Consortium for Climate Change has been established in which more than 80 universities and institutions are affiliated. to observe and monitor Air Quality Index of Bahawalpur. Cooperation with the Punjab government is ongoing on the project of special agro-economic zone in Cholistan through rain increase system, which will bring 6 million hectares of land under cultivation and increase the agricultural economy of the country by 10 billion dollars annually. Proactive, real-time data management can expose a wide range of unknown challenges associated with occupancy, building use, and peaks in utility usage. corrective actions to prevent critical shutdowns, and manage loads before they affected the entire system". 

PhD Admissions:
