This session marked a pivotal moment in the university's commitment to enhancing academic excellence and strengthening its international standing. During the meeting, Prof. Dr. Muhammad Asadullah Madni, Director Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC), provided a comprehensive overview of the university's QA mechanisms. The briefing covered both internal and external quality checks, as well as the strategic initiatives in place to improve IUB's position in global university rankings.



The discussion focused on several areas, including ongoing internal evaluations, stakeholder feedback analysis. The IQC also reviewed the accreditation status of various programs. The Vice Chancellor praised the QEC team's efforts and emphasized the importance of a collaborative and data-driven approach to quality assurance. He issued directives to further institutionalize best practices across all academic and administrative units.

Stanford University USA released the ranking of two percent of the best scientists in the world. 35 teachers of the IUB have joined the top 2% scientists worldwide for the year 2024.

Assessment of different academic programs

QEC successfully conducted a comprehensive assessment from the May to June 2025 of its different programs of Faculty of Veterinary and Animal Sciences, Faculty of Computing, Pharmacy, Faculty of Agriculture & Environmental Sciences, Faculty of Chemical & Biological Sciences, Faculty of Physical & Mathematical Sciences, Faculty of Management Sciences, Faculty of Law, Faculty of Social Sciences, Faculty of Education, Faculty of Arts & Languages and Faculty of Islamic Studies & Arabic.







The assessments were carried out by Program Assessment Teams (PAT). The PAT teams consisted of concerned Deans, Director QEC/Deputy Director QEC and Chairperson Department concerned. Dean faculty concerned presided the assessment activity in their respective faculty. The assessment aimed to evaluate the effectiveness of the academic programs, identifying areas of strength & weakness, and providing recommendations for improvement.

QEC organized orientation sessions on Program Review for Effectiveness and Enhancement (PREE) using Internal Quality Assurance methods. 
Prof. Dr. Madni delivered a series of



In the QS World University Rankings 2026, IUB is ranked 18th in Pakistan and placed in the 1401+ category globally. In the QS Asia University Rankings 2025, the university is ranked 22nd nationally, positioned 401-410 in Asia, and 107th in South Asia. Furthermore, in the QS Sustainability Rankings 2025, IUB achieved 14th place in Pakistan, 395th in Asia, and 72nd in South Asia, while falling in the 1181-1200 global bracket, and 1001+ in the specific categories of

Environmental Impact, Social Impact, and Governance.
